The Trust Foundation is a charitable trust which has proudly supported the Australian Community since 1985, and is now celebrating its 22nd year.

In the beginning

It began as The Centenary Foundation to celebrate 100 years of business for Trust Company. It was set up with a \$100,000 donation from the then Union-Fidelity Trustee Company of Australia Limited (now Trust Company Limited).

In 2002 it was renamed Trust Foundation to demonstrate the association with the new branding.

Today

Thanks to the generosity of our many philanthropic clients, the Foundation has now grown to over \$40 million in funds. The causes it now supports range from medical and marine research, to helping financially disadvantaged university students and projects to help indigenous communities.

How does it work?

The Trust Foundation gives its donors the confidence, support and security of grantmaking within a large and well established Foundation.

You can give to the Foundation as a whole, or establish a named management account under the umbrella of the Foundation. An example of this is the Trust Foundation - Russell Webb Legacy which was established after the Beaconsfield mine disaster. Brant Webb

and Todd Russell, the two survivors of the earthquake and subsequent mine collapse, established their management account through the Trust Foundation to support the youth of the Beaconsfield community.

The work of the Foundation is governed by the terms of its trust deed. This means that it is maintained exclusively for public charitable purposes in the Commonwealth of Australia. These purposes are determined by the trustees in line with the Foundation's stated objectives.

Donations are tax-deductible and can take many forms including cash, gifts, payroll deductions and bequests under a will or deed.

Making donations

There are a number of ways that you can support the Trust Foundation:

- through a once-off donation
- by setting up a regular payment direct from an account
- making a bequest in a Will
- establishing a management account within the Foundation.
