

## **ADMINISTRATION OF A CHARITABLE TRUST FOR ILL OR DISABLED CHILDREN**

On 18 March 2011, the New South Wales Supreme Court declared that the original purpose of the charitable trust known as the 'Kyle Williams Home Trust', established to provide a convalescent home for children, could not be performed. The Court will order a scheme for the administration of the trust property.

- (a) The property situated at 52 Waratah Street, Blakehurst, in the State of New South Wales ("the Home") or funds realised from the sale of that property; and/or
- (b) Other funds held by the Kyle Williams Home Trust –
